Completion of requirements in the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) will permit a student to transfer from a community college to a campus in either the California State University or the University of California system without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower division, general education courses to satisfy campus general education requirements. ALL COURSES MUST BE COMPLETED WITH GRADES OF "C" OR BETTER. A COURSE MUST APPEAR ON IGETC IN THE YEAR IT IS SATISFACTORILY COMPLETED. See a counselor/academic adviser about UC majors, colleges, and professional schools which do not accept IGETC, and for other transfer requirements. Upon enrolling in final course requirements and receiving conditional admissions to the University, students must submit a request for certification to De Anza's Office of Admissions and Records. Completion of the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) will permit a student to transfer from a California Community College (CCC) to a California State University (CSU) or University of California (UC) campus generally without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower-division, general education (GE) courses to satisfy campus GE requirements. IGETC is also accepted by some independent and out-of-state universities. IGETC is most useful to students who plan to transfer but have not yet decided upon a particular institution, campus or major.

IGETC is not a transfer admissions requirement* nor is it the only way to fulfill lower-division breadth/GE requirements prior to transfer. Completing it does not guarantee admission to the campus or program of choice. However, completing lower division breadth/GE requirements before transfer – whether through IGETC or CSUGE or the campus specific requirements – may improve a transfer applicant’s chances for admission to a competitive campus and/or program. Use of IGETC

IGETC is not appropriate for most high-unit majors that require extensive lower division preparation like Engineering and the sciences. Check ASSIST (www.ASSIST.org) for more information.

The following are general campus guidelines for UC. **IGETC is not appropriate for:**

- **Berkeley** – The Colleges of Engineering, Environmental Design and Chemistry, and Haas School of Business. Though IGETC satisfies Breadth requirements for most majors in the College of Natural Resources, specific lower division major requirements must still be satisfied. Check ASSIST to determine appropriateness.
- **Davis** – BS degree programs and high unit majors, School of Engineering
- **Los Angeles** – Henry Samueli School of Engineering and Applied Sciences, School of Nursing – RN/BS/Post licensure program
- **Merced** – Schools of Engineering and Natural Sciences
- **Riverside** – The College of Natural and Agricultural Sciences, College of Engineering
- **San Diego** – Eleanor Roosevelt and Revelle Colleges
- **Santa Barbara** – College of Engineering
- **Santa Cruz** – Jack Baskin School of Engineering
- Former UC students returning to the same campus cannot use IGETC.

Courses on IGETC

- A course must appear on IGETC (in the specified Area) the term it’s completed in order to apply. Courses may be added to IGETC mid-academic year. Students should always refer to the most up-to-date IGETC pattern when selecting courses each term. Check www.ASSIST.org and www.deanza.edu/transfer/csuge.html (or) www.deanza.edu/transfer/ucge.html on a regular basis.
- IGETC courses must be completed with a grade of C or better (C- is not allowed). A grade of “Credit” or “Pass” may be used if the community college’s policy states it is equivalent to a grade of C or better. A “Pass” at De Anza is achieved with a grade of C or better.
- Though a course may be listed in more than one Area, it can only be counted in one Area for certification.

A few things to consider: All UC and a few CSU campuses set limits on the number of units that may be taken for Credit/Pass. UC allows IGETC courses to double-count towards major requirements, while CSU has campus-specific policies that could restrict this practice. Courses used towards a major must be taken for a letter grade unless otherwise specified. Check college catalogs/Web sites for campus policies.

Coursework from Other Colleges

- Courses taken at another CCC will be applied in the approved Areas designated by that college when the courses were completed. Check www.ASSIST.org
- Courses from regionally accredited institutions could apply towards IGETC as long as they meet IGETC criteria and standards.
- Only foreign coursework from US regionally accredited institutions may be applied to IGETC.

Students must arrange to have transcripts sent to De Anza – Admissions and Records Office (A&R). Once transcripts are on file, students are advised to meet with a counselor to request to have those transcripts evaluated. Evaluation time varies so this process should be initiated as soon as possible. If we are unable to determine the applicability of a non-CCC course towards IGETC, it is the student’s responsibility to provide additional information on the course. Writing samples may be needed for courses reviewed for Areas 1A and 1B.

IGETC Certification

The IGETC certification is an official document sent directly from De Anza to another institution verifying the courses/AP exams applied to IGETC. This is not an automatic process. Upon enrolling in final required courses and receiving conditional admissions to the university, students must submit a request for certification to De Anza - Admissions and Records Office. All necessary documentation (high school/college transcripts, AP) must be received and evaluated by De Anza prior to this request. Note: The certification process may be delayed if transcripts/exams have not been previously evaluated. Exams

- Advanced Placement (AP) – official reports must be sent to De Anza (A&R) directly from the College Board in order to apply

- International Baccalaureate (IB) – official reports must be sent to De Anza (A&R) directly from the IB Organization in order to apply.

- College Level Examination Program (CLEP) – cannot be used on IGETC.

UC Language Other Than English (LOTE - Area 6) Students may demonstrate proficiency for the purpose of fulfilling the Language Other Than English IGETC requirement in several ways. Go to www.deanza.edu/transfer/ucge.html to view options.

It is strongly recommended that students complete IGETC prior to transfer and obtain full IGETC certification. If, however, this is not possible, a partial certification may be issued. Students are responsible for determining the appropriateness of a partial certification and should consult with a counselor. Partial certification is defined as completing all but one (1) or two (2) courses on the IGETC pattern. Once partially certified, it is the student’s responsibility to work with the counselor at the university to find out how to complete IGETC requirements. The UC/CSU is responsible for verifying that the missing IGETC course(s) has been completed and students should not request a full certification from De Anza after transfer.

Warning: Students must complete Areas 1 and 2 to meet minimum admission requirements for UC/CSU, so if you are missing courses in either Area your eligibility for transfer will be at risk.
***Caution:** A university or specific program may specify that full IGETC certification is required for admission. Students should check on the conditions for admission outlined by the university/program. Example: Full IGETC certification is a selection criterion for admission to UC Berkeley’s College of Letters & Science. Any student offered admission on the condition that they submit full IGETC certification but then submits a partial IGETC certification, could have their positive admission decision reversed.
