HEALTH BENEFIT UPDATES: 3 ITEMS

Below is the latest health benefit news for FHDA retirees.

- ♦ Lisa Markus, De Anza Mathematics faculty member and FA Vice President, will continue as the Union Chair on the Joint Labor-Management **Benefits** Council (JLMBC). Recall that the JLMBC is a structured forum for the District's five unions (FA, ACE, Teamsters, OE3, and CSEA) to meet with management to share health benefit information. interests and proposals, and attempt to arrive at consensus through deliberation and compromise. FODARA representatives Tom Strand and Faith Milonas, along with Confidential and Administrative Management Association representatives, are advisory, non-voting attendees.
- ♦ The newly created Voluntary Employee Beneficiary Association (VEBA) trust fund for post-'97 hires will receive a onetime \$800K transfer from the District in January 2017. Current plans envision continued trust funding via the \$2/\$4/\$6 (EE, EE+1, Family) monthly contributions from FHDA employees and retirees. The VEBA trust was set up to help qualified faculty hired after 1997 with the cost of Medicare Part B. Currently there are three such eligible FHDA retirees who will receive approximately \$100 per month.

The JLMBC took a preliminary look at coverage for hearing devices (highquality hearing aids range from \$1,000 to \$3,000 per ear and higher). For pre-'97 retirees, CalPERS health care plans typically provide some hearing device coverage, while VSP members are also eligible for discounts via TruHearing. Explore your options by studying your CalPERS plan description and clicking on https://www.truhearing.com/vsp/. The JLMBC will discuss this topic more fully at its next meeting in January.

MONEY MATTERS!

Not only were our numbers down at the Pizza Thing this year, but our numbers are also down for dues and scholarship donations. By this time last year, 117 people had sent in their \$10 dues. This year, only 25 folks have responded. Last year we had accumulated over \$1,900 in voluntary donations for student scholarships. This year, we have collected \$470. "Mother Hubbard's Cupboard" is not bare, but it is down by \$2,372 over what was on the shelves last year.

For 2016, FODARA contributed \$6,000 for six \$1,000 student scholarships—three for Foothill and three for De Anza (read the winners' stories on the FODARA website www.deanza.edu/fodara/scholarships.htm).

For 2017, FODARA has approved \$5,000 for scholarships, four of \$1,250, two at each campus. So we need your help. Hopefully, now that elections are over, we can refocus on different issues. Any dues received now through June of 2017 will be recorded for this school year.

"WEP" UPDATE

Faculty who receive Social Security benefits are probably familiar with the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP), which reduces benefits based on non-Social Security earnings, such as those from a community college. Read about the intent. and affect of the WEP history, www.ssa.gov/pubs/EN-05-10045.pdf.

New legislation is stumbling through congress that proposes to reconfigure (in most cases reduce) the WEP "penalty" for both current and future Social Security recipients. H.R. 711 (the Equal Treatment of Public Servants Act, Brady, R-TX), if passed in its original form, would result in higher Social Security benefits for most retirees subject to the WEP.

The good news is the bill has a reasonable chance of passing: its sponsor chairman of the committee jurisdiction over the bill; it has bipartisan support; and it is cost neutral. The bad news is in mid July, H.R. 711 was pulled from consideration due to а last-minute substitution that provided almost no benefit for those currently subject to the WEP (the name of the sponsor of this revision is not noted in the update). Brady and NARFE immediately objected to the change and, along with the Teacher's Retirement Board and AARP, will continue to support the bill only in its original form.

NARFE urges retirees who favor a redo of the WEP to contact their members of congress or submit letters to their local newspaper in support of H.R. 711.
