Heidi and Casie presented Google Forms as a temporary or permanent platform for the guided self-placement tool. (Slides following.) The request to transition the GSP to Google Forms was approved by consensus. Casie re-emphasized that the timeline to make this change must be no later than December 9. The Assessment Center would host International Student Program assessment week on December 9. During this week, the Center would serve 80+ students each day.

GUIDED SELF-PLACEMENT (GSP) PLATFORM HISTORY

- October 2017 AB705 Bill is signed by the Governor
- January 2018 AB705 legislation goes into effect
- November 2018 Canvas is identified as the GSP math and English assessments platform
- December 2018 through March 2019 Faculty develop GSP content & Heidi designs the branching features
- April 2019 Platform beta testing
- July 2019 Assessment Center launches the GSP Math and English assessments using Canvas
- Beginning September 4, 2019 GSP Canvas courses start freezing (students cannot complete assessments; Canvas cannot replicate the reported issues)

CONSIDER GOOGLE FORMS WITH NEW! QUIZ FEATURE

- New! quiz feature now includes branching abilities
- This platform can be the GSP temporary or permanent platform
