Subject: SANKOFA Tracking – Fall 2010, Winter 2011 and Spring 2011

Success rates of students enrolled in SANKOFA courses designated by a course offering number ending in SKS or SK were compared to the average success rates of students in all other sections of the same level course in the same quarter. In fall 2010, SANKOFA offered COUN080X, in winter 2011 EWRT001A and HUMA020 were offered, and in spring 2011 COUN080X and EWRT002 were offered. Demographic information for SANKOFA students in the three quarters was also provided.

### **Success Rates**

- In fall 2010, the SANKOFA COUN080X course had a success rate of 75%. No other sections of this course were offered in this quarter.
- In winter 2011, SANKOFA students enrolled in EWRT001A exhibited a slightly lower success rate (79%) than students in all other sections of the course (82%). SANKOFA students enrolled in HUMA020 had a success rate of 91%, no other sections of this course were offered this quarter.
- In spring 2011, SANKOFA students enrolled in COUN080X exhibited lower success rates (77%) than students in all other sections of the same course (96%).
  SANKOFA students enrolled in EWRT002 in spring 2011 exhibited higher success rate (83%) than students in all other sections of the same course (81%).

### **Demographics**

- SANKOFA students largely identify as Black or African American (40%) followed by Asian (18%) and Latino (13%) students.
- The majority of SANKOFA students were enrolled full-time at 74%
- While the majority of SANKOFA students are residents (93%), a small proportion (4%) identified as non-resident international students or AB540 students (2%).
- SANKOFA students largely declared their education goal as 'Obtain AA and transfer to a 4-year college' (66%), followed by 'Transfer to a 4-year college without an AA' (20%).
