SUBJECT: Nursing Program Clinical Survey, Winter 2011

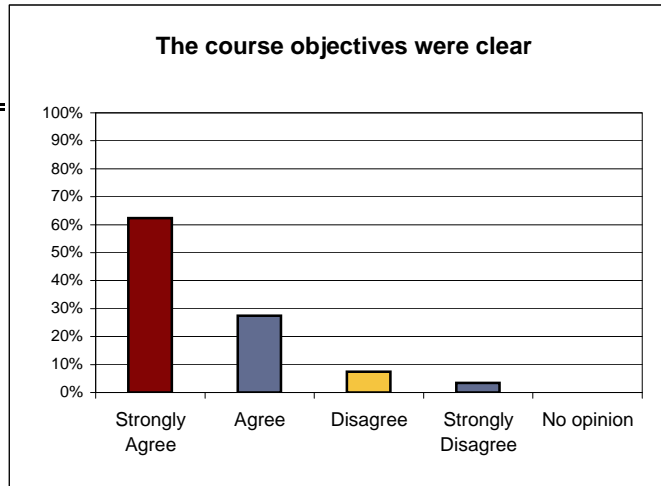
A survey was sent by faculty to students of De Anza College enrolled in the Nursing Program during the winter quarter 2011. A total of 167 students responded to the survey online.

Important highlights include:

- 90% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the course objectives were clear and obtainable; and the complexity of the course was appropriate for this level.
- 96% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the amount of work required for this course was appropriate for the credit received.
- 91% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the required textbook for this course was helpful for meeting the objectives.
- 85% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the out-of-class assignments (e.g., A.V., group activities, etc.) were relevant to the course objectives.
- 88% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the out-of-class suggested reading and A.V. assignments were accessible.
- 89% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the assigned reading and A.V.s for this course were appropriate.

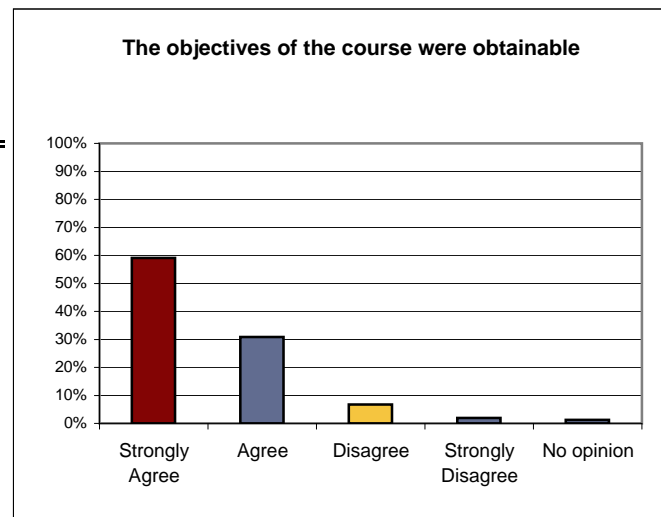

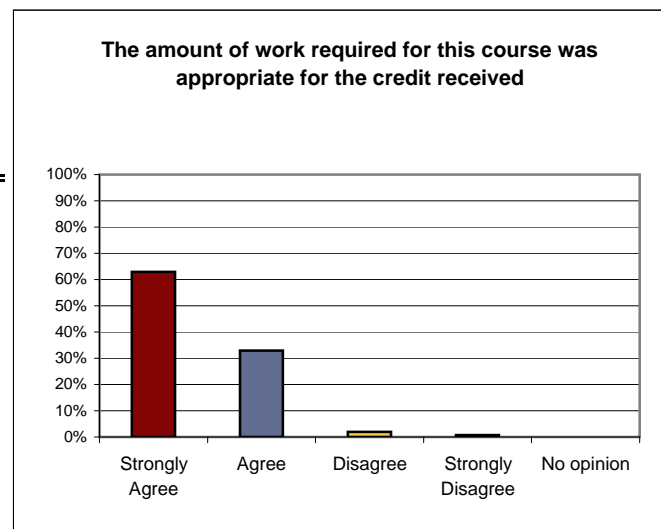

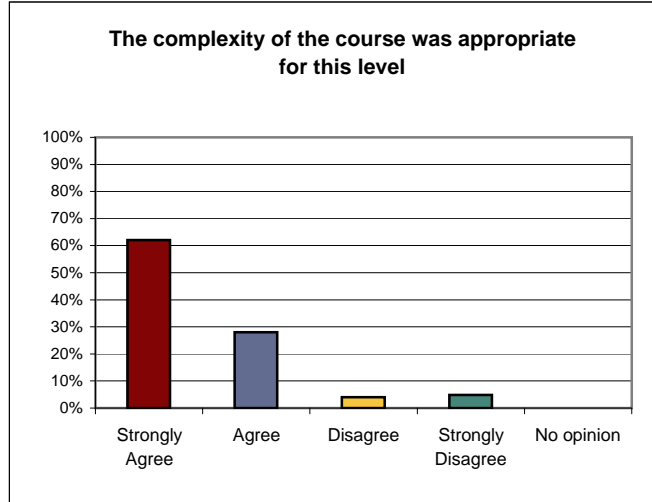

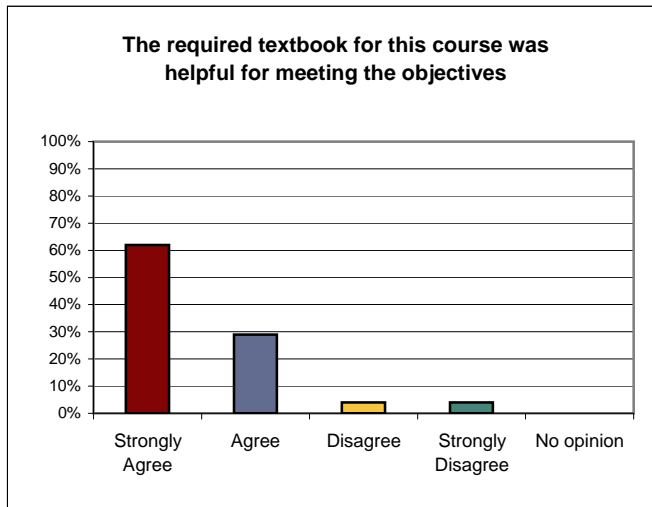

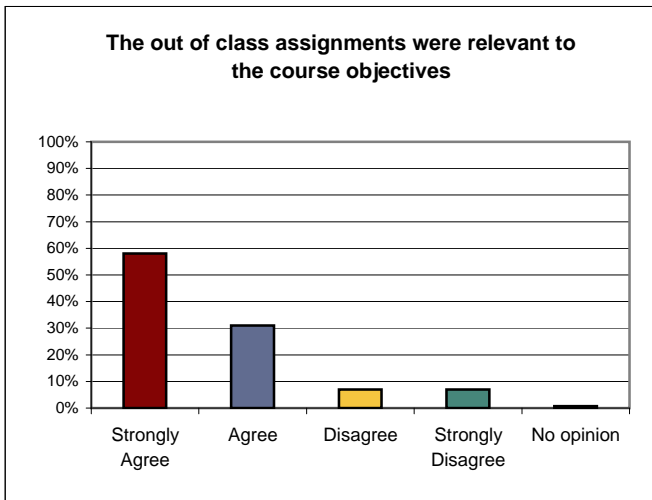

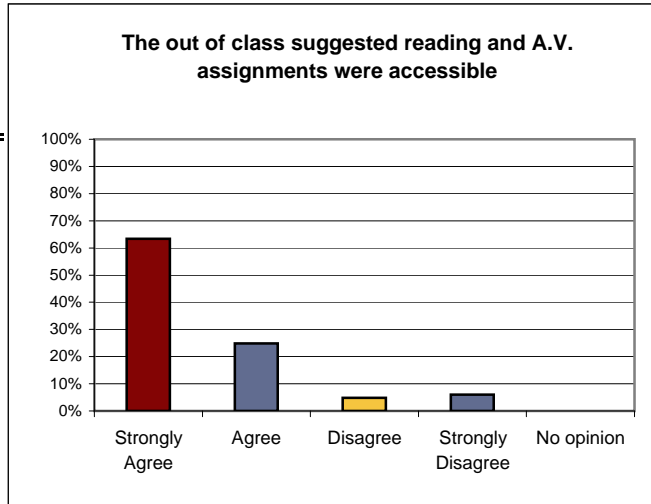

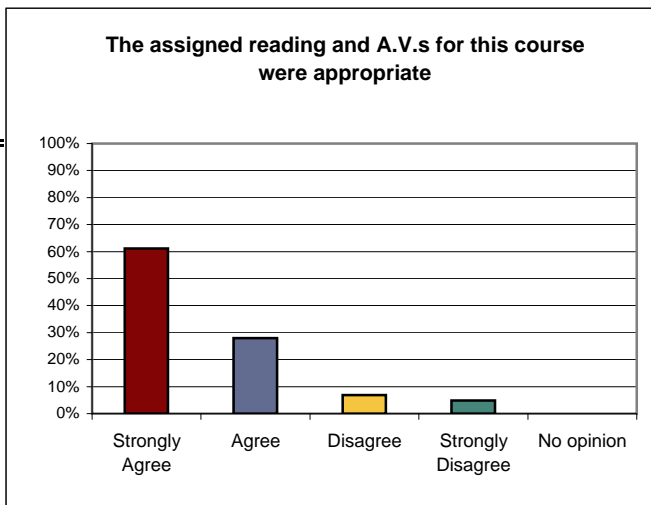
