SUBJECT: Nursing Program Theory Survey, Winter 2012

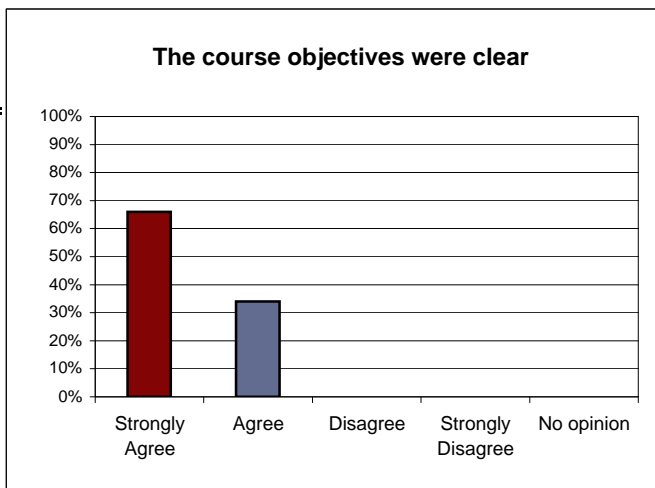
A survey was sent by Nursing Program faculty to students of De Anza College enrolled in the Nursing Program during Winter quarter 2012. A total of 185 students responded to the online survey.

Important highlights include:

- 100% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the course objectives were clear.
- 99% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the objectives of the course were obtainable; and the complexity of the course was appropriate for this level.
- 98% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the tests (quizzes, etc.) in this course related to the course objectives; and the course has helped them to improve in clinical performance.
- 97% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the out-of-class suggested reading and A.V. assignments were accessible; the class time allowed for discussion and questions was appropriate; and compared to other courses in their major, they would rate this course as effective.
- 96% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the topics covered in exams and assignments for this course were consistent with the course objectives.
- 95% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the assigned reading and A.V.s for this course were appropriate; and the lectures/demonstrations in the course were appropriate.
- 94% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the out-of-class assignments (eg., A.V., group activities, etc.) were relevant to the course objectives; and the course was well structured (ie., the progression seemed logical).
- 92% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the required textbook for this course was helpful for meeting the objectives.
- 91% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the methods for presenting content were effective.
- 89% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the amount of work required for this course was appropriate for the credit received.
- 87% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the assigned papers for this course contributed to the achievement of course objectives.

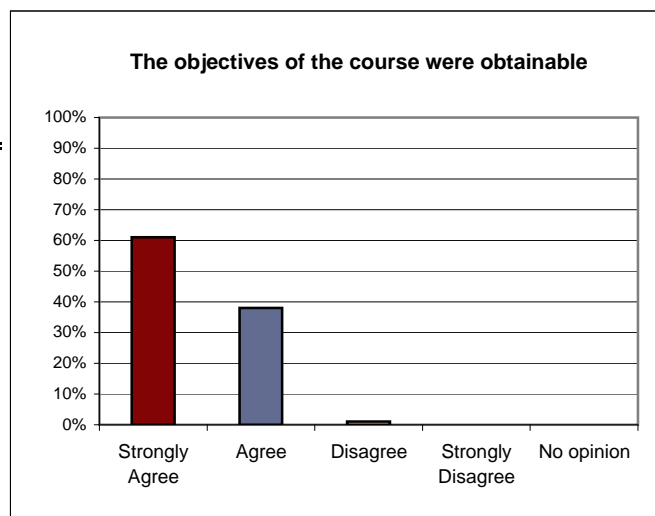

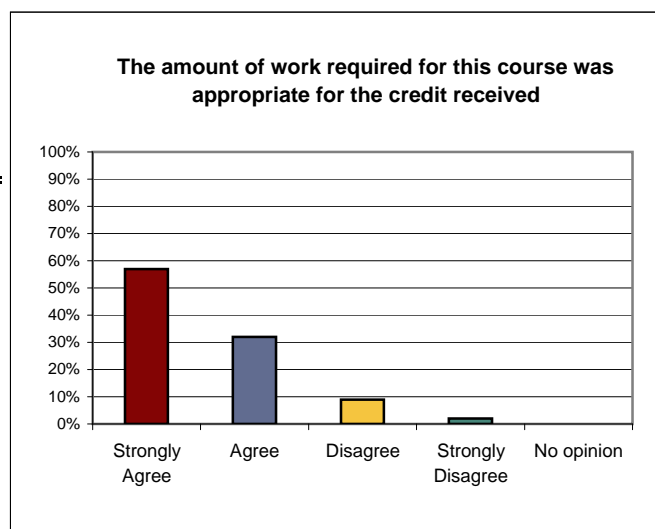

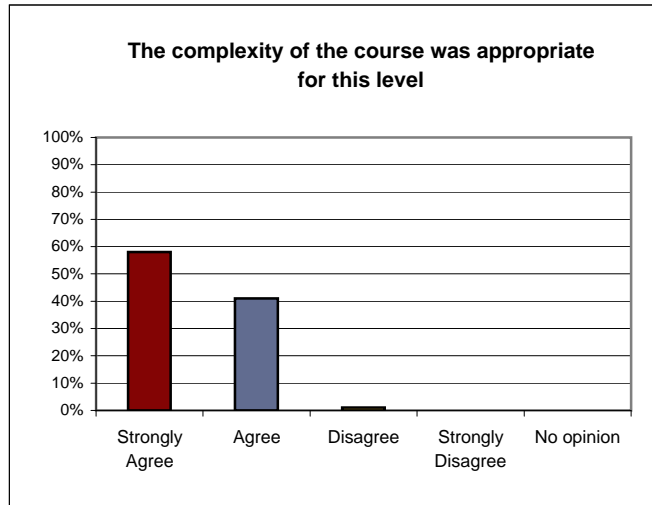

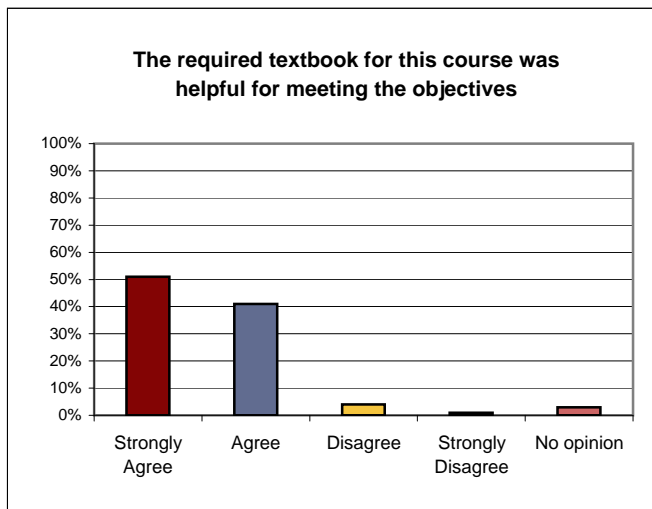
4. The complexity of the course was appropriate for this level

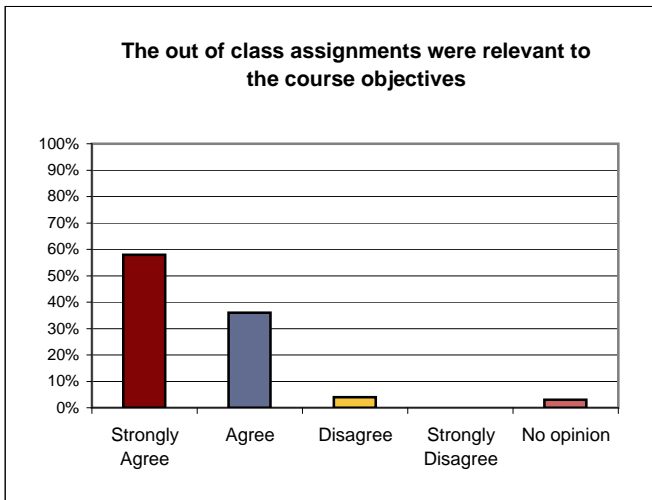
5. The required textbook for this course was helpful for meeting the objectives

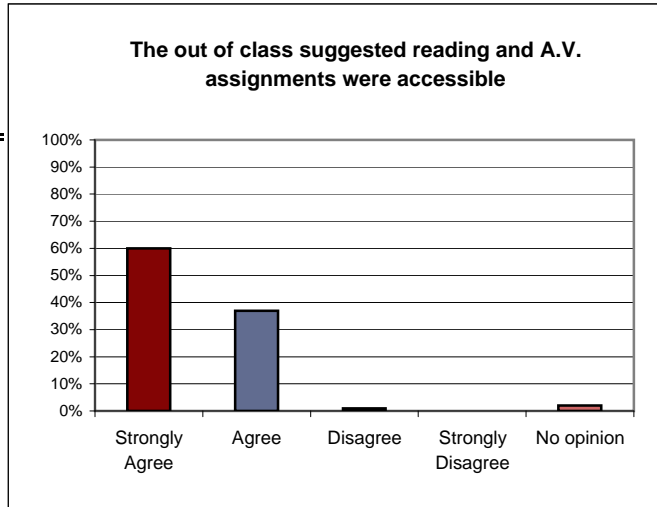

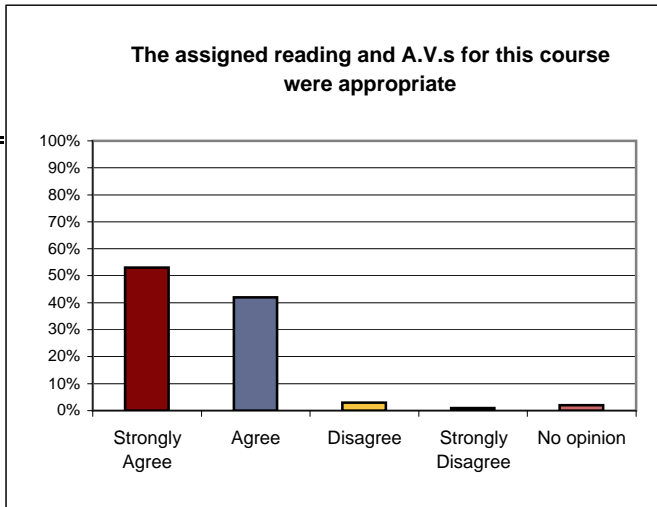

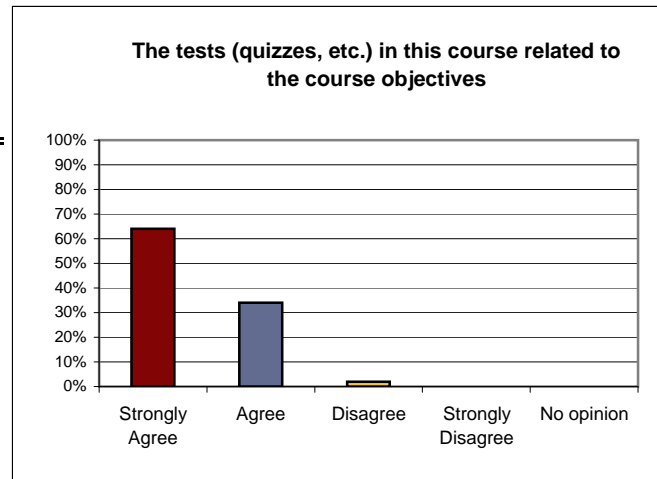

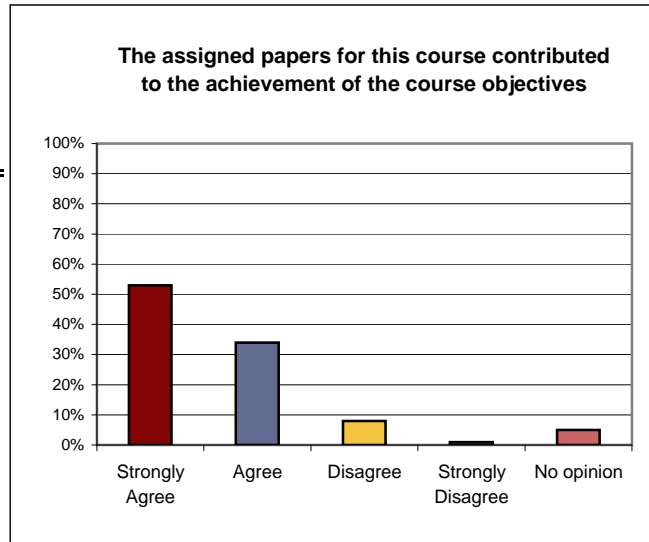

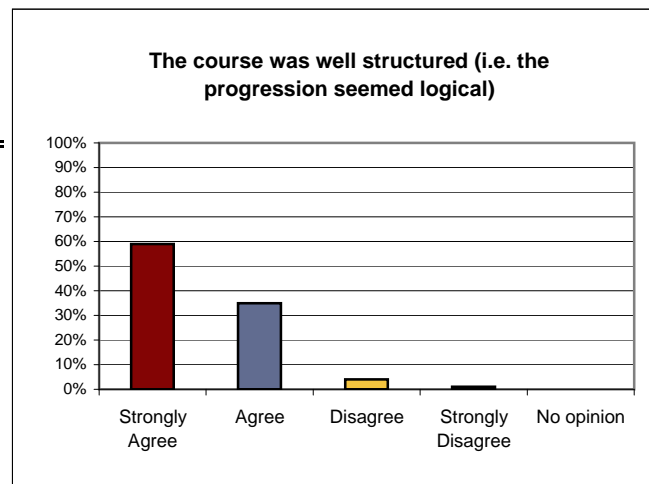

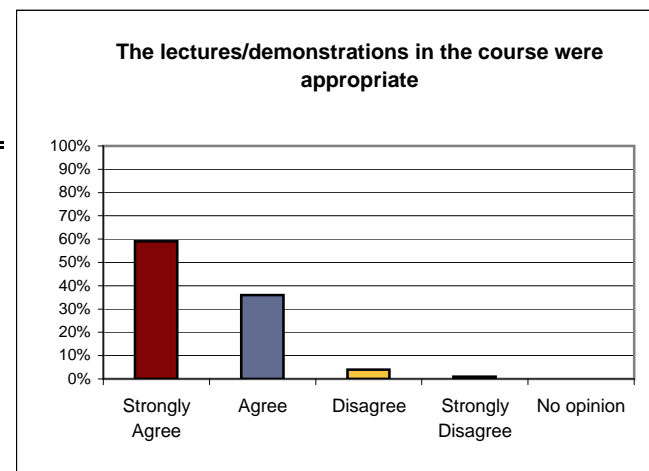

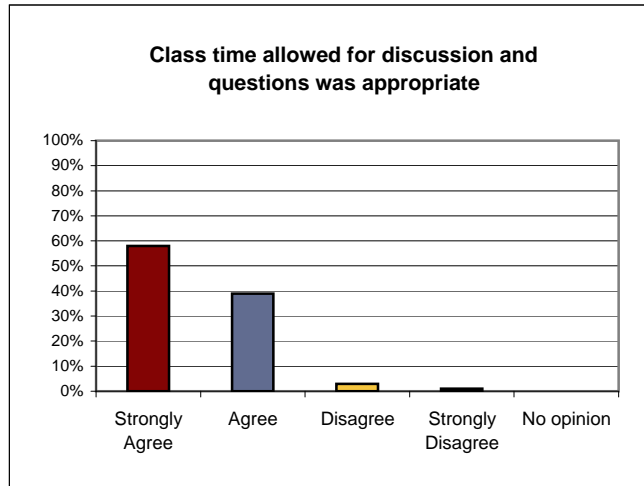

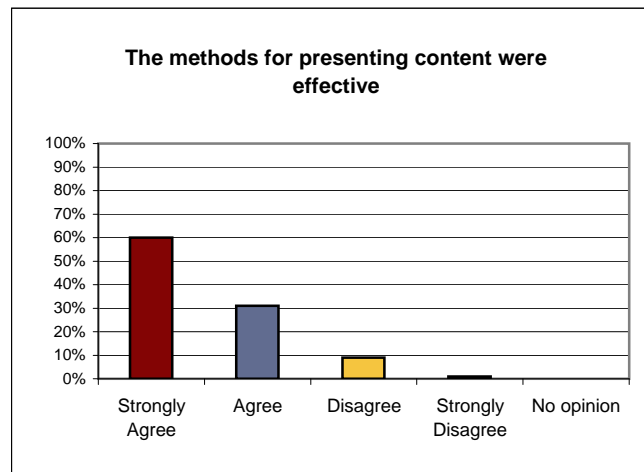

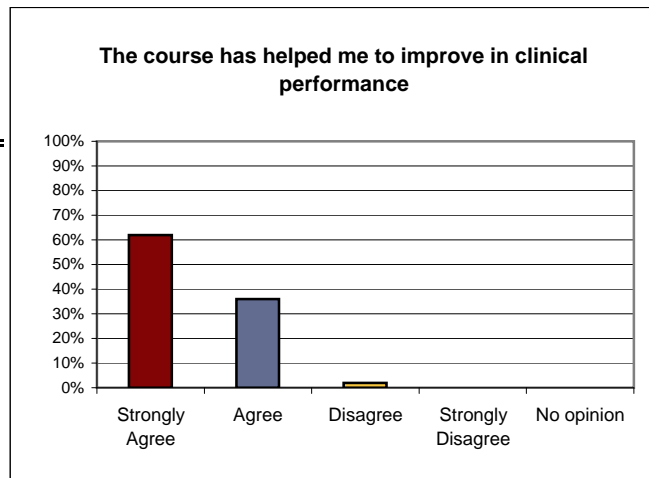

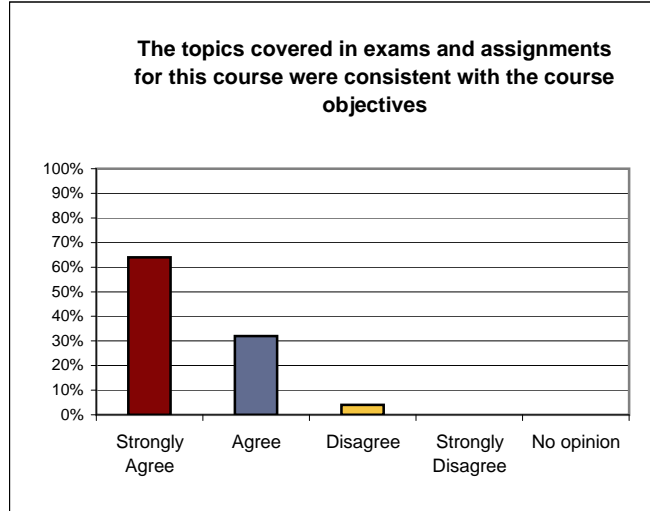

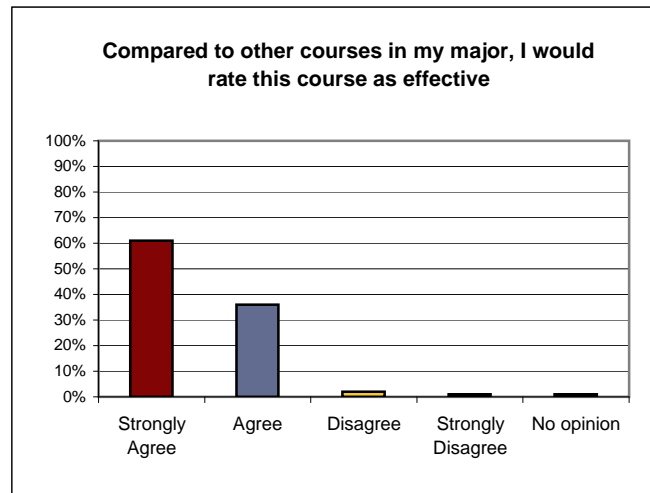
