NURS86L

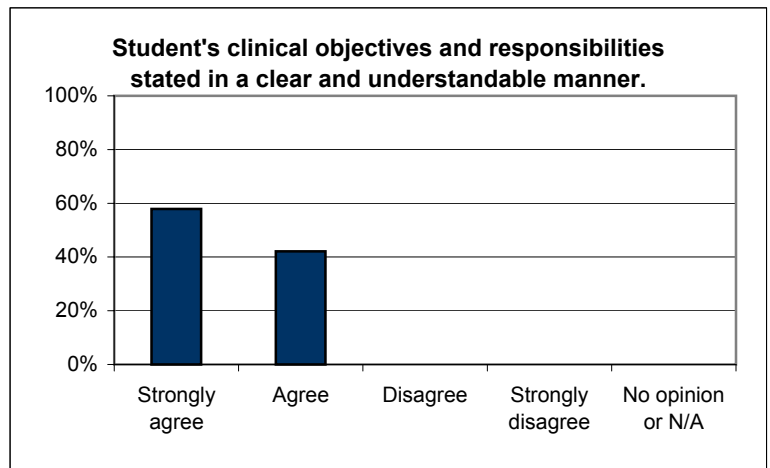
A total of 19 students from NURS84L instructed by Sherri Cozzens (12 students) or Peggy Smith (7 students) responded to the survey.

Important highlights include:

- 100% of the students strongly agreed or agreed that their clinical objectives and responsibilities were stated in a clear and understandable manner.
- 90% of the students strongly agreed or agreed that learning experiences selected were based on individual student needs.
- 90% of the students strongly agreed or agreed that the course “demonstrates understanding and sensitivity to student needs.”
- 95% of the students strongly agreed or agreed that the course “encourages realistic goals for student performance.”

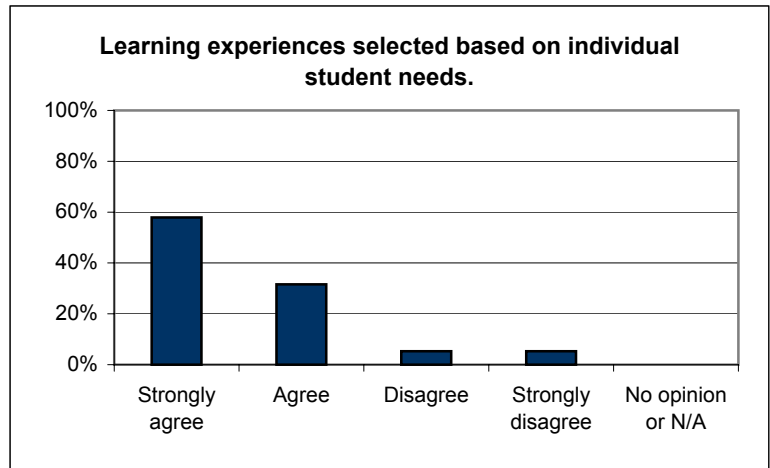
1. Student's clinical objectives and responsibilities stated in a clear and understandable manner.

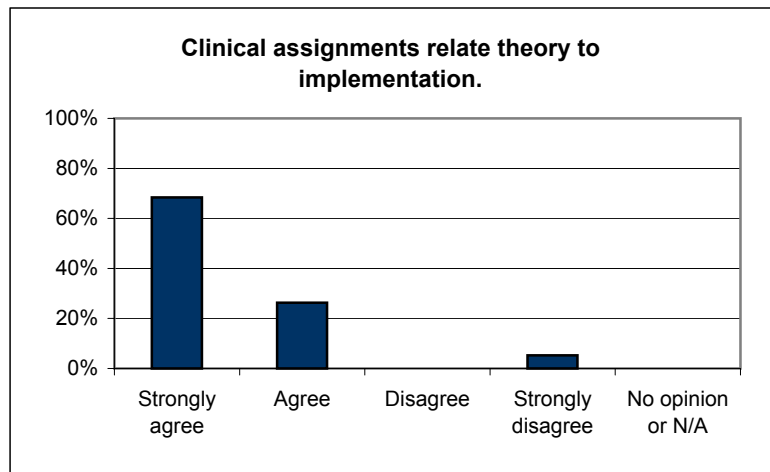
2. Learning experiences selected based on individual student needs.

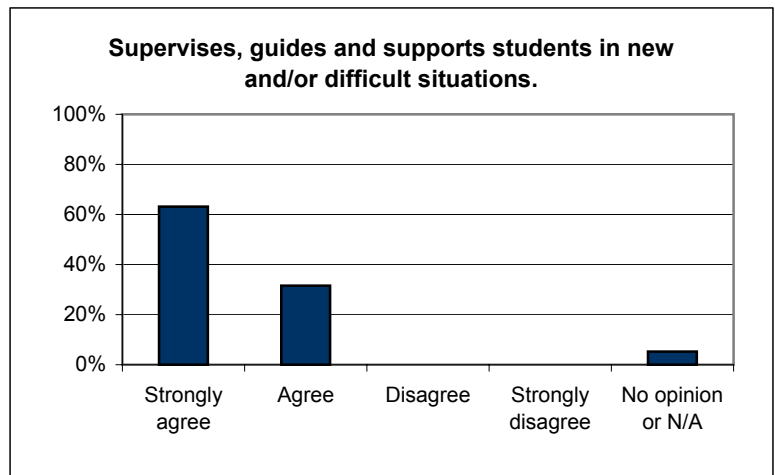
3. Clinical assignments relate theory to implementation.

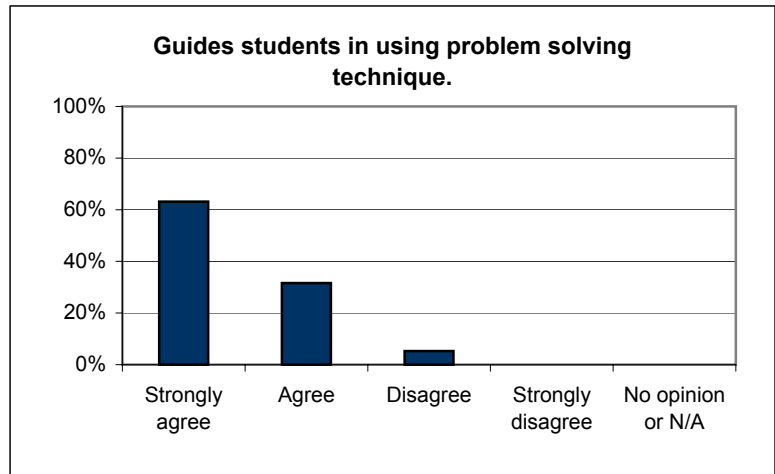
4. Supervises, guides and supports students in new and/or difficult situations.

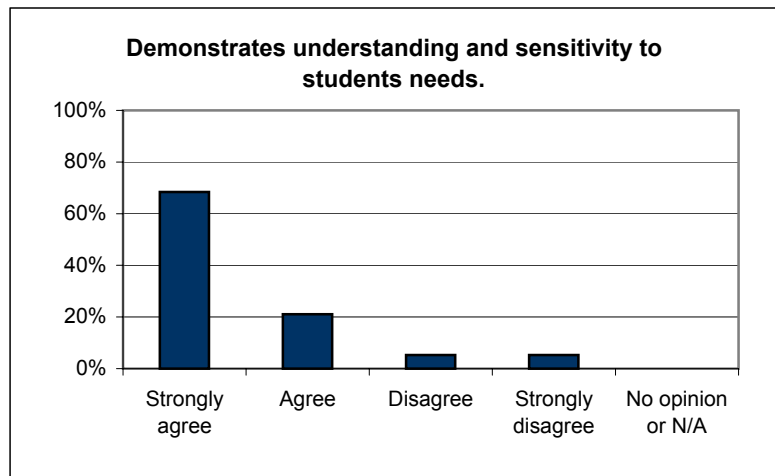
5. Guides students in using problem solving technique.

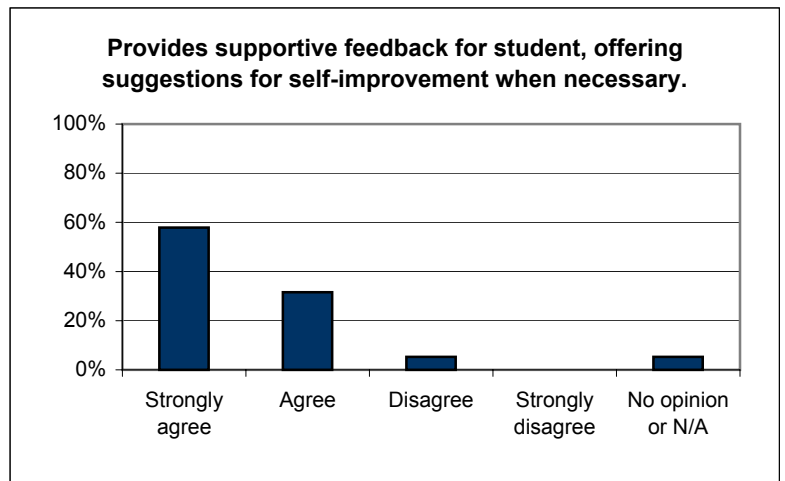
6. Demonstrates understanding and sensitivity to students needs.
