Verification will occur electronically on your behalf if you turn in your Request for Degree for your ADT by the mid-March deadline ○ If the status on the Check Status page of your CSU application is “pending verification” or “not verified” after March connect with your counselor or Transfer Center for Support on ADT Verification.
<p>Spring</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❑ CSU and UC campuses will announce transfer admission decisions. Keep your grades and GPA up as admissions offers are contingent on you finishing well. ❑ Commit to a school. This often costs money and is non-refundable, so decide carefully or ask about deferment considerations. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 5/01: CSU - Submit Intent to Enroll ○ 6/01: UC - Submit Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) ❑ After saying yes to your university and paying the enrollment fee, request GE Certification. ❑ Review to-do list, send final transcripts and/or test scores to the school you will be attending, check portal for due dates. ❑ Share your Good News with the Transfer Center. ❑ Celebrate your achievement! Sign-up to participate in end of the year celebrations! ❑ Sign up for the Transfer Achievement Celebration to receive your Transfer Achievement Medal. ❑ Attend transfer student orientation provided by your transfer university. ❑ Finalize housing arrangements.
